Pantomime is a great opportunity to introduce new music to a production that otherwise Barnstormers might never perform. "Cinderella" is no exception to this and features songs from hit stage and screen musicals such as "Mamma Mia", "The Lion King" and "The Greatest Showman", but also new and relatively unknown songs such as "It's Time To Dance" from the 2018 Broadway musical "The Prom". There is also a wide range of pop music from artists such as Bruno Mars and Christina Perri, to Lad Baby and Bob The Builder. If that isn't enough there is also classical music from Richard Strauss, Cole Porter and a variation on a Tchaikovsky melody. There aren't many theatre platforms that give scope for such a wide variety of musical content in one show.

A huge credit must be given to Imogen for selecting a great set of music, and for doing a fantastic job in directing her first show for Barnstormers. I hope we get to see her direct many more



shows in the future and that she also inspires the next generation of Directors to take up the challenge.

My thanks also, as always, to the ever-faithful team of dedicated musicians who turn up show after show and put up with mindless musical modifications, strange shoulder shrugs, and tenuous tricky tempos. The show, and Barnstormers, wouldn't be the same without them.
