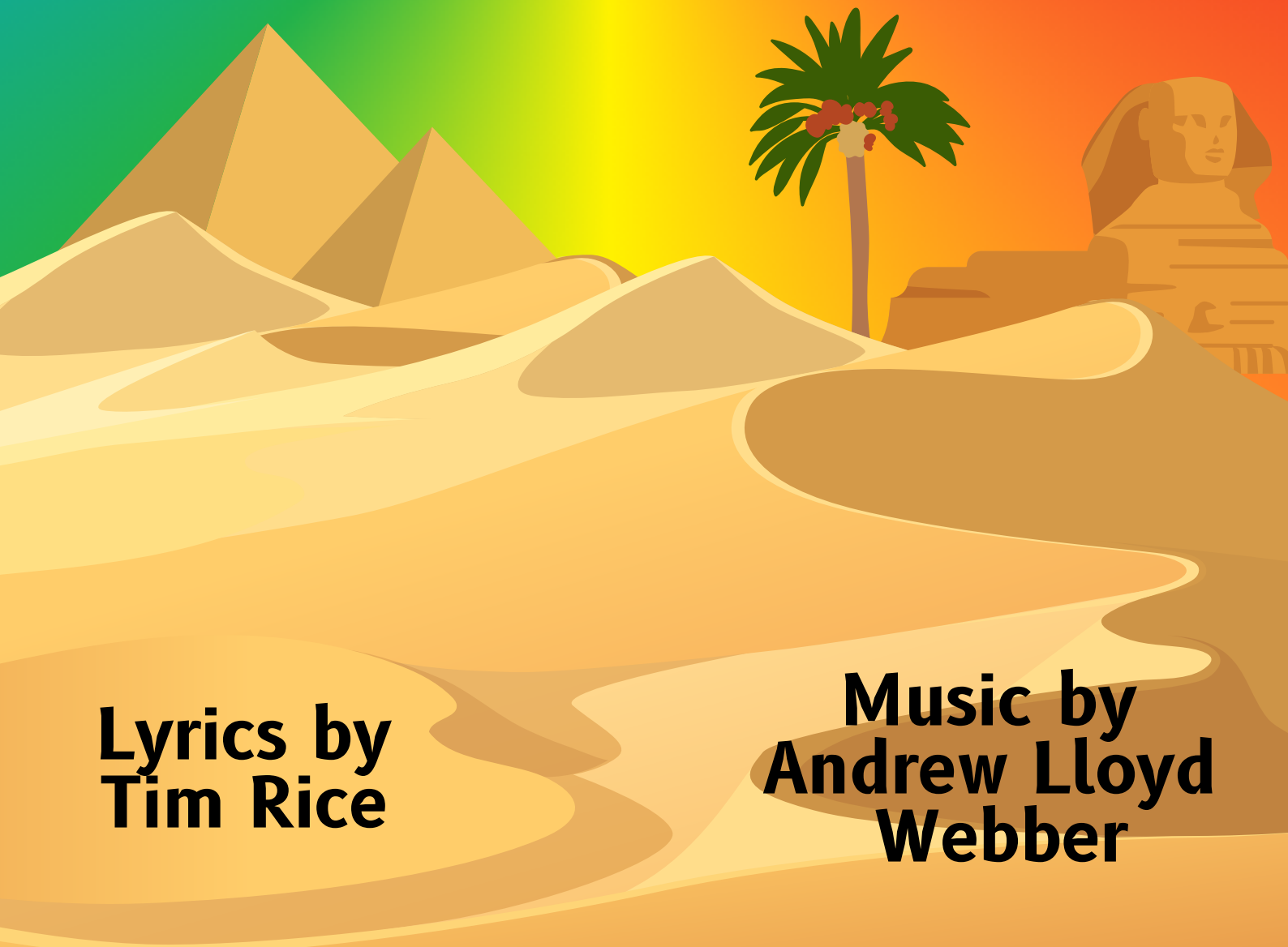

Based on the biblical story of Joseph from the Book of Genesis. This high-energy, family-friendly production follows the journey of Joseph, the favoured son of Jacob, whose gift of dream interpretation takes him from betrayal and slavery to power and reconciliation.

Told entirely through song with a dazzling mix of musical styles—from pop and rock to calypso, French chanson, and country-western—Joseph is a joyful, fast-paced celebration of dreams, resilience, and unity, brought to life with colourful costumes, dynamic choreography, and unforgettable tunes.

The Bible Story of Joseph

Genesis, chapters 37-50

Joseph, the eleventh son of Jacob and the first son of Rachel, is favored by his father, who gives him a richly ornamented coat. His brothers become jealous and sell him into slavery, telling their father he was killed by a wild animal. Joseph is taken to

Egypt, where he serves in the house of Potiphar, a high-ranking official. Despite his integrity, he is falsely accused by Potiphar's wife and thrown into prison.



In prison, Joseph gains a reputation for interpreting dreams. Eventually, Pharaoh learns of his gift and summons him to interpret troubling dreams. Joseph reveals that Egypt will face seven years of abundance followed by seven years of famine. Impressed, Pharaoh appoints Joseph as second-in-command to oversee preparations.

During the famine, Joseph's brothers come to Egypt to buy grain. They don't recognize him, but Joseph tests their character. Eventually, he reveals his identity, forgives them, and brings the entire family to Egypt, saving them from starvation. The story ends with a message of reconciliation, God's providence, and the triumph of faith through hardship.

“Jacob loved Joseph more than any of his other children because Joseph had been born to him in his old age. So one day he gave Joseph a special gift—a beautiful robe.” Genesis 37:3

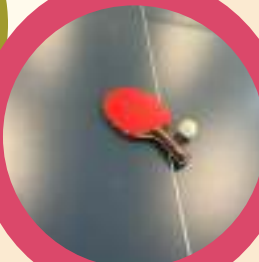

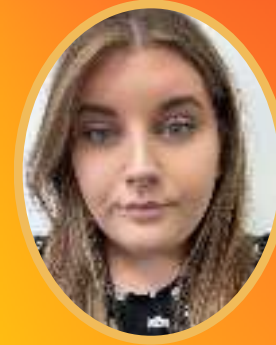

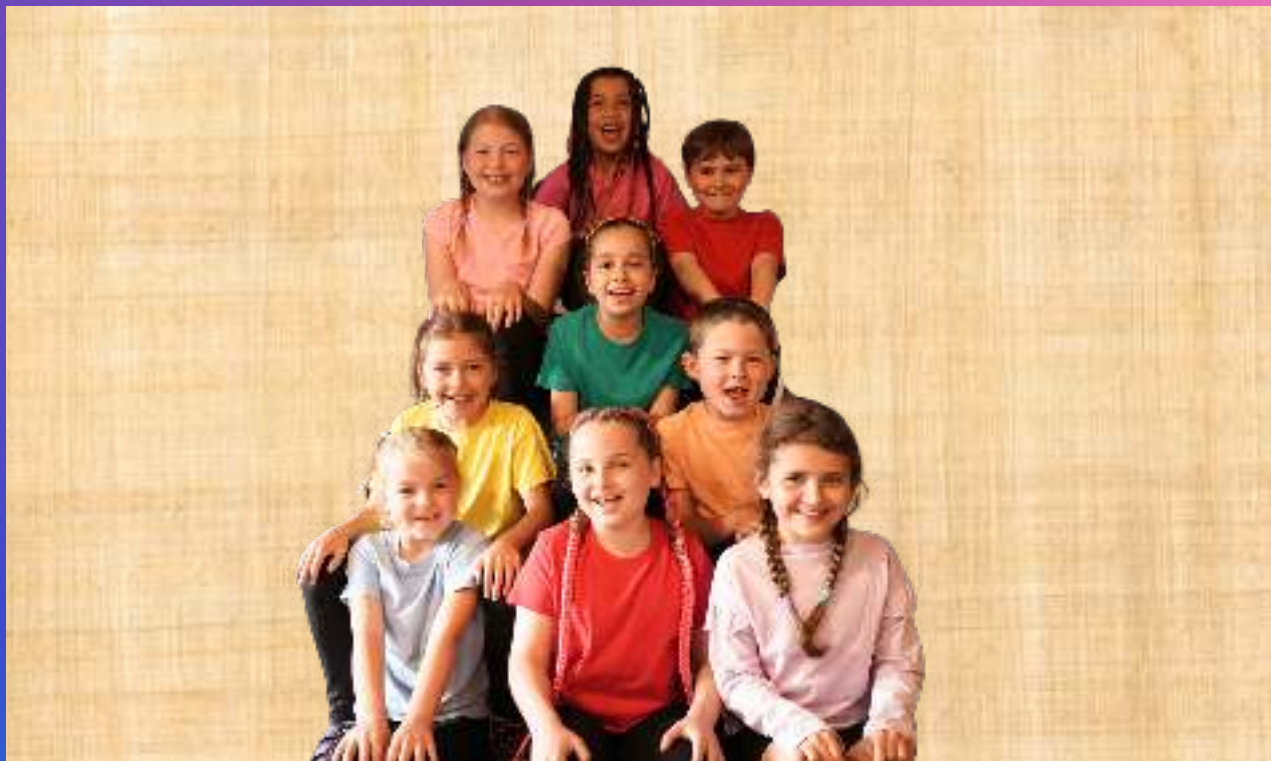
